1. Who is Evolve2 65 Flex for?

8 am meeting at home. 3pm presentation in the office. And a catch-up on the commute in-between.

Evolve2 65 Flex is the ultimate headset for the most hybrid of workers - the get-up-and-go people who can't predict where they'll be working on a daily basis. With its revolutionary fold-and-go design, sleek profile, extra-thin ear cups, hidden boom arm, and wireless charger, the Evolve2 65 Flex is the perfect companion for those who want to make every place their workstation - whether that's at home, the office, or a noisy café.



2. How does Google fast pair work?

We know your time is valuable, so we've made Evolve2 65 Flex easy and lightning-fast to use.

When Evolve2 65 Flex is placed next to an Android device, and in Bluetooth® pairing mode, the user will get a pop-up notification on the Android device, for one simple tap to pair the headset.

Think of it as ready, headset, go.

All supported Android devices (running Play services 11.7+ with compatibility back to Android 6.0) can use Fast Pair. This includes all your current and future Android phones (6.0+) associated with your Google Account. For the advanced personalization feature and 'Find My Device' integration you need an Android device with Android 10 or later.



3. How big is Evolve2 65 Flex when folded?

Small in size, big on professionalism, Evolve2 65 is incredibly slim measuring only 37mm height, 18.8 length 9.9 width. It is the most portable headset compared to its competitors in this price range.



4. What is Jabra ClearVoice Microphone system?

If you find yourself in a noisy location, we wanted to make sure you'll still be heard perfectly. Jabra ClearVoice is a proprietary, state-of-the-art technology that combines a multi-microphone system with beamforming and superior algorithms, designed by Jabra. It meets the 'premium microphone for the open office' requirements adjusting a precise balance between cancellation of background noise and other people's voices with speech clarity enhancement.

Jabra ClearVoice is designed to meet the needs of the most demanding users, allowing them to make calls and attend meetings in even the noisiest environments - even when chatty colleagues or loud family members are talking right next to them.



5. What does “meeting Open Office requirements” mean?

For those times when the meeting room is double-booked and you have to take that call in a less than quiet part of the office, Evolve2 65 Flex allows you to still hear, and be heard.

When the Evolve2 65 Flex’s boom arm is pulled down, it meets premium microphone for open office standards. This qualification is the strictest test requirement of how the headset microphone suppresses surrounding noise and office conversation from multiple directions. It is the ultimate reassurance that your headset will excel in an open office environment.



6. What is Jabra Air Comfort technology?

Back-to-back meetings can mean being in your headset all day, so we've created something to take the pressure off even when you've got your headset on. Jabra Air Comfort is a new comfort technology that features redesigned earcup cushions with a new pattern and material that distributes pressure on the ear more evenly. We've also changed the inside of the ear cups with a softer, more responsive material that helps to relieve pressure on the ears. The headband features a new perforated design that distributes pressure more evenly on the top of the head so you'll feel like you're not even wearing a headset during your long meetings. Our engineers spent years perfecting Jabra Air Comfort technology so you can look forward to a new level of feel-good factor during meetings and calls.

Jabra Air Comfort comes with the Evolve2 65 Flex, Evolve2 55 and Evolve2 50.



7. What does made for iPod/iPhone/iPad mean?

“Made for iPod/iPhone/iPad” means that an electronic accessory has been designed, checked and approved to connect to iPhone, iPad, and iPod models. You don’t just have to take our word for it – it’s been certified by the developer to meet Apple performance standards.



8. What is MySound for music?

How do you make your favorite track sound even better? MySound is a Jabra Sound+ feature in which an audio test is performed to create a personalized audio profile. Your MySound profile is then used to calibrate your Evolve2 65 Flex to optimize your music listening experience.



9. What is ANC?

A buzzer-happy delivery driver arriving mid-conference call. Your dog barking in the background of that crucial client chat. We've all had one of those days. Active Noise Cancellation (ANC) is a technology used to reduce unwanted background noise. It works by using microphones outside the headset's earcup (feedforward) to pick up the ambient noise around you, then generating sound waves that are the exact opposite, or "negative," of the ambient noise. These negative sound waves effectively cancel out the background noise, allowing you to hear your audio more clearly.



10. What is Hybrid ANC?



Our engineers have gone the extra mile to keep things oh-so-quiet for your calls on your oh-so-busy days. Hybrid ANC is a technology that combines feedforward and feedback ANC by placing microphones on the inside and outside of the ear cup. It can suppress noise at a broader range of frequencies than regular ANC technologies, it can adapt to and correct errors, and is not as sensitive to how the person wears the headset.



11. What is Advanced ANC?

Advanced ANC utilised the same hybrid ANC technology, but with a more effective performance because of a dedicated chipset and 4 levels of noise cancelling adjustment



12. Why can I not wear Evolve2 65 Flex microphone on both sides?



This is where the phrase fit-for-purpose applies. Evolve2 65 Flex, just like the rest of Evolve2 line, was engineered to radically improve comfort and sound performance: for that reason the earcups were designed with an asymmetrical shape to better fit the ears and the head shape. Wearing the microphone on either side would require symmetrical / round ear cups that would compromise on both comfort and audio quality.

13. Does Evolve2 65 Flex work over a cord with Audio over USB?

Yes, Evolve2 65 Flex has Audio over USB at FCS.

14. Are there any other products using Jabra AirComfort Technology?

Yes, Evolve2 55 and Evolve2 50 also feature Jabra AirComfort technology.



15. How can a shorter boom arm deliver the same great performance meeting premium microphones for the open office?



Our engineers were able to achieve this level of microphone performance with a shorter boom arm through different technologies. Evolve2 65 Flex has a new, powerful chipset that is entirely dedicated to cancelling background noise from calls. Four beam-forming microphones placed in different parts of the headset capture sound inputs from different directions and transmit those signals to a new algorithm that process sound separating speech audio from noise. Put together, the whole package is small but mighty – incredible sound in a compact form.

16. How does Evolve2 65 Flex compare to Krisp.ai and Microsoft Teams software-based noise suppression?

We don't like to brag, but... software based noise suppression can cancel basic background noise i.e. a keyboard tapping but it doesn't come near to what Evolve2 55 and professional noise cancelling headsets can do. Software based noise cancellation cannot cancel speech and human voices, which are some of the most common types of noises in hybrid work situations i.e. if your partner at home or your colleague in the office is speaking near you, the headset will be able to cancel that as opposed to software noise cancellation. Software noise suppression also requires computer CPU, which consumes more battery, and often affects speech quality i.e. with sound delay, and it is not available on mobile.



17. Can I connect my headset using both USB-A and USB-C?

Yes. You can choose between a USB-A or USB-C Bluetooth adapter.



18. Can I pair this headset with iPhone and Android?

Yes. The first time you turn on your Jabra Evolve2 65 Flex, it is ready to pair with your mobile device.

19. Does it work with Microsoft Teams?

Yes. Jabra Evolve2 65 Flex comes in two variants – UC-certified and optimized for Teams.

20. Does the headset come with the Bluetooth adapter?

Yes. The headset is supplied with the Jabra Link 380.



21. Does the headset come with a charging stand?

There is a handy optional charging stand, which is available as an add-on accessory.



22. Does it have a 3.5 mm jack?

No. Evolve 2 65 Flex does not have a 3.5 mm jack. If you're looking for 3.5mm jack connectivity, try the Evolve2 85.



23. What is the wireless range from my computer/ mobile device?

Whether you use the supplied Bluetooth adapter with your computer, or you are connected to a mobile device, you will get up to 30 m/100 ft wireless range whilst on a softphone call or listening to music.



24. How long does the battery last?

With Evolve2 65 Flex you will get up to 21 hours battery talk-time (without ANC on).



25. Does it work with Microsoft Teams?

Yes. Jabra Evolve2 65 Flex comes in two variants – UC-certified and optimized for Teams.

26. Does it work with Mac and PC?

Yes. It works with both systems.



27. Can I use Jabra Evolve2 65 Flex with my smartphone and tablet?

Yes. You can connect your headset to both your computer (with the supplied Jabra Link 380 Bluetooth adapter) and your smartphone or tablet at the same time.



28. Is Jabra Evolve2 65 Flex compatible with Link 950?

Yes, Evolve2 65 Flex is compatible with the latest version of Link 950 only.



29. What does it mean the Evolve2 65 Flex are certified?

Evolve2 65 Flex is certified by tech giants like Microsoft, Zoom and Google. Certified devices have been specifically designed and built to plug-and-play and work seamlessly with your virtual meeting apps, for enhanced compatibility and a better experience compared to non-certified devices.
